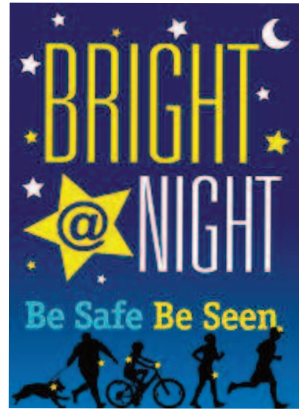
Attendance for last week
